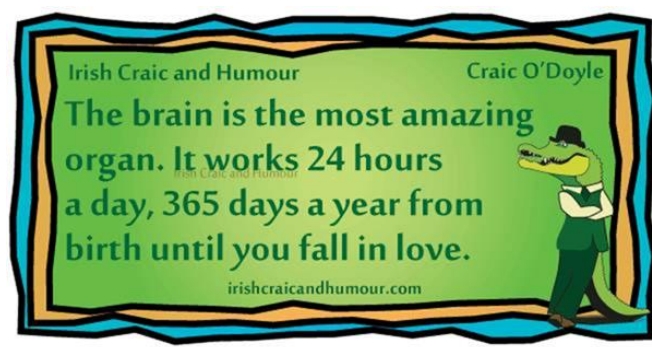
In the end the BBQ at Les Creux was a great success and enjoyed by all of those who attended. The food was good and there was plenty of space to maintain the required social distancing.
